## **ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT**

The year 2023 commenced on a wonderful note when the results of our school of 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> classes CBSE Board Examination came out. We are happy to share the details of the commendable performances of our students.

The students of Class 12 have showcased a remarkable execution of hard work with 100 % of result in CBSE Board exams 2023-24. A total number of 86 students appeared for the Class XII Examinations set by CBSE Board. Jagriti of class 12<sup>th</sup> was the topper of Humanities stream as well as the Overall Topper of the school. Janvi Allawadhi and Maganjot Singh topped the Commerce stream and Science Stream respectively. The students of Class 10<sup>th</sup> have scored a remarkable execution of hard work with laudable 100% result in CBSE Board Exams, 2023-24. A total number of 114 students appeared for the examinations set by the CBSE Board. Sargun Kaur stood first scored 479 out of 500 with 95.8 % result.

## **IMPORTANT SMC DECISIONS**

To increase the student interest and motivation, integrating skill modules and Languages- French & Sanskrit were introduced in the middle segment of the school in the session 2023-24.

To promote many of the social and emotional learning (SEL) skills that are crucial students' academic achievement, Psychology and Painting subject is proposed to introduced from the session 2024-25.

Fee Hike proposal is also passed to increase school fee to generate funds for expansion and betterment of educational facilities in 2024-25.

## **FACILITATORS**

The most valuable resource that any school can have is its staff.

The school collectively has a passionate and committed team of 56 facilitators in the Senior Secondary, Secondary, Primary and Pre-Primary sections. In addition, we have Non-teaching and Support Staff. The school can run smoothly and expanded with new ideas because of their cooperation with one another. The shift that creates new value and opens doors to success and improvement is known as innovation. The school is constantly seeking innovation and using the most recent pedagogical approaches.

Each academic year, trainings seminars and orientation programmes are conducted for teachers and students with a dual focus to improve and effectively implement innovative ideas in teaching learning practices as well as to take the students beyond their current level of learning.

### **Capacity Building Programmes for Teachers**

With the sole purpose of updating teachers' knowledge, the school hosted a series of Teachers' Workshops. ### **CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:**
